 To attend / to sit an exam (faire l'examen)
 Ex: I sat my final exam today.
 To listen to (the radio) (écouter la radio)
 Ex: I listen to the radio everyday.
 Fake news (fausses nouvelles passant aux infos(plus ou moins))
 Ex: "Tupac is still alive living in Cuba" would be fake news.
 News conference = Press conference (conference de press)
 Ex: They had a press a press conference today about the Olympics.
 Soap Opera (feuilleton)
 Ex: I watched the soap opera "Casualty" last night.

Present perfect: -Past action with an effect on the present
 -Without a date
 -"already, ever, just, since, for, get" VOCA

-For → duration
 -Since → Starting point

Ex: I have been working at EISTI for 5 years / I have worked...

 NOT "many persons"
