

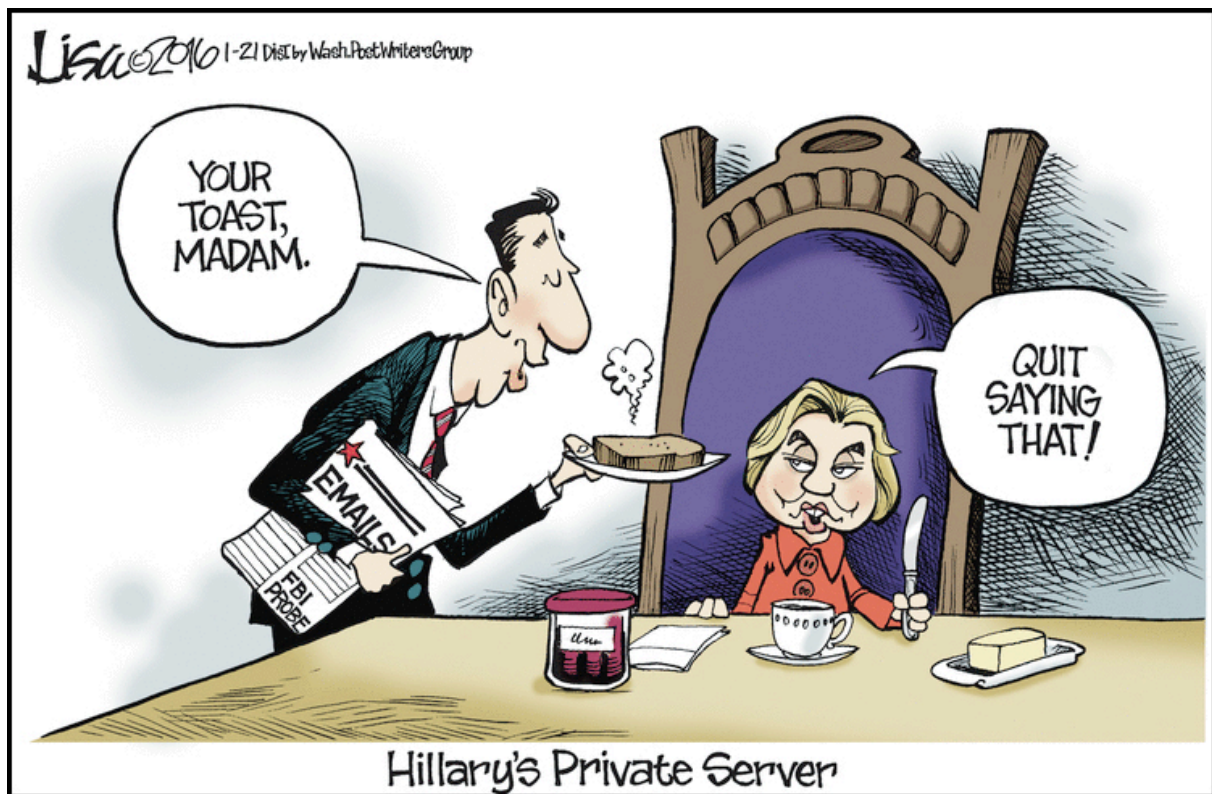

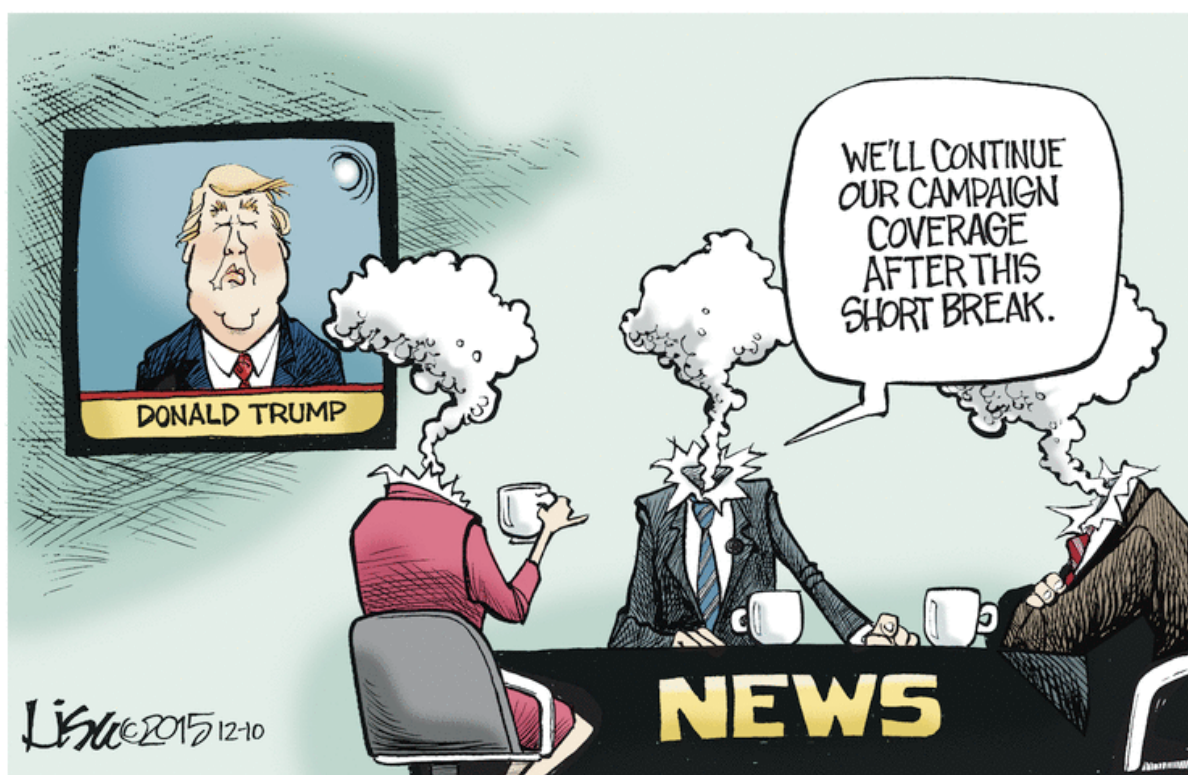


Media on Trump

Merriam-Webster defines *steamed* as: informal, meaning angry or irritated. e.g. I am so steamed! What latest news from Donald Trump has the media steamed?



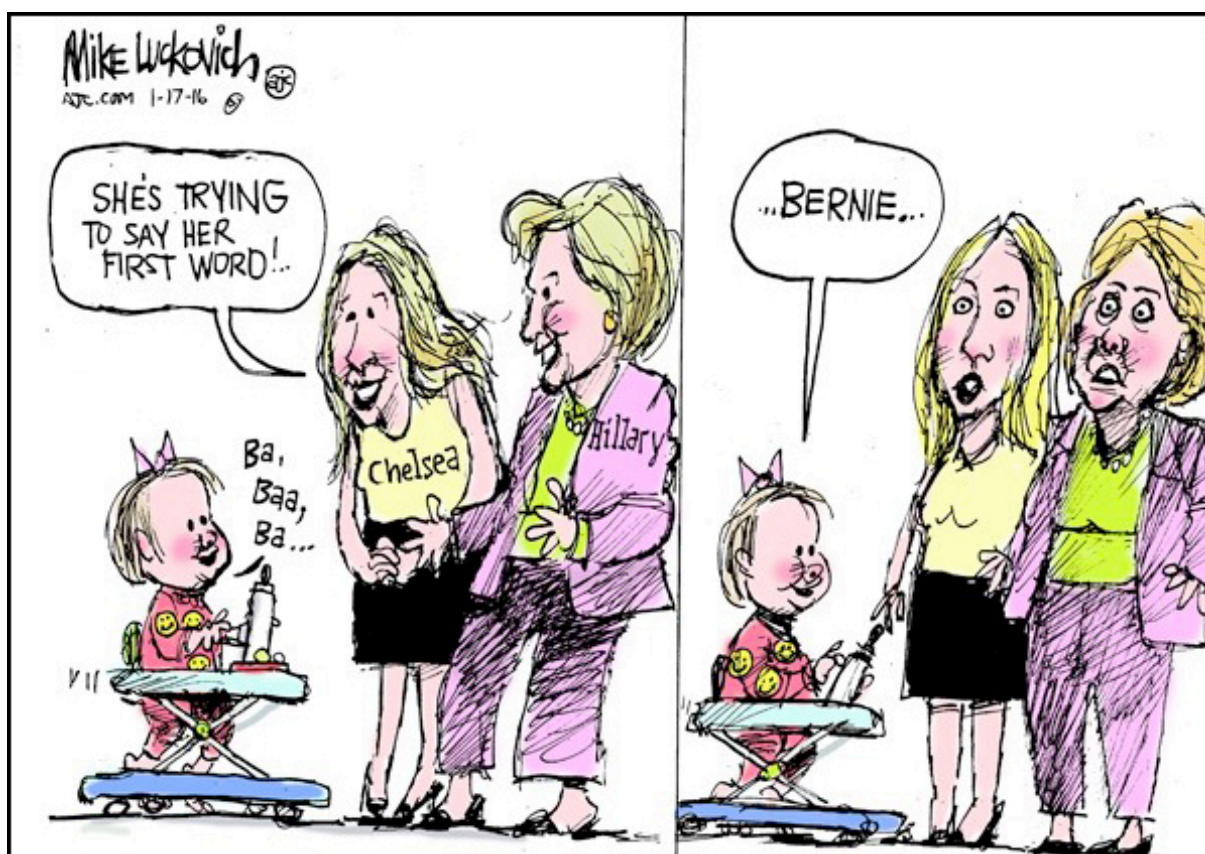

- e) understatement

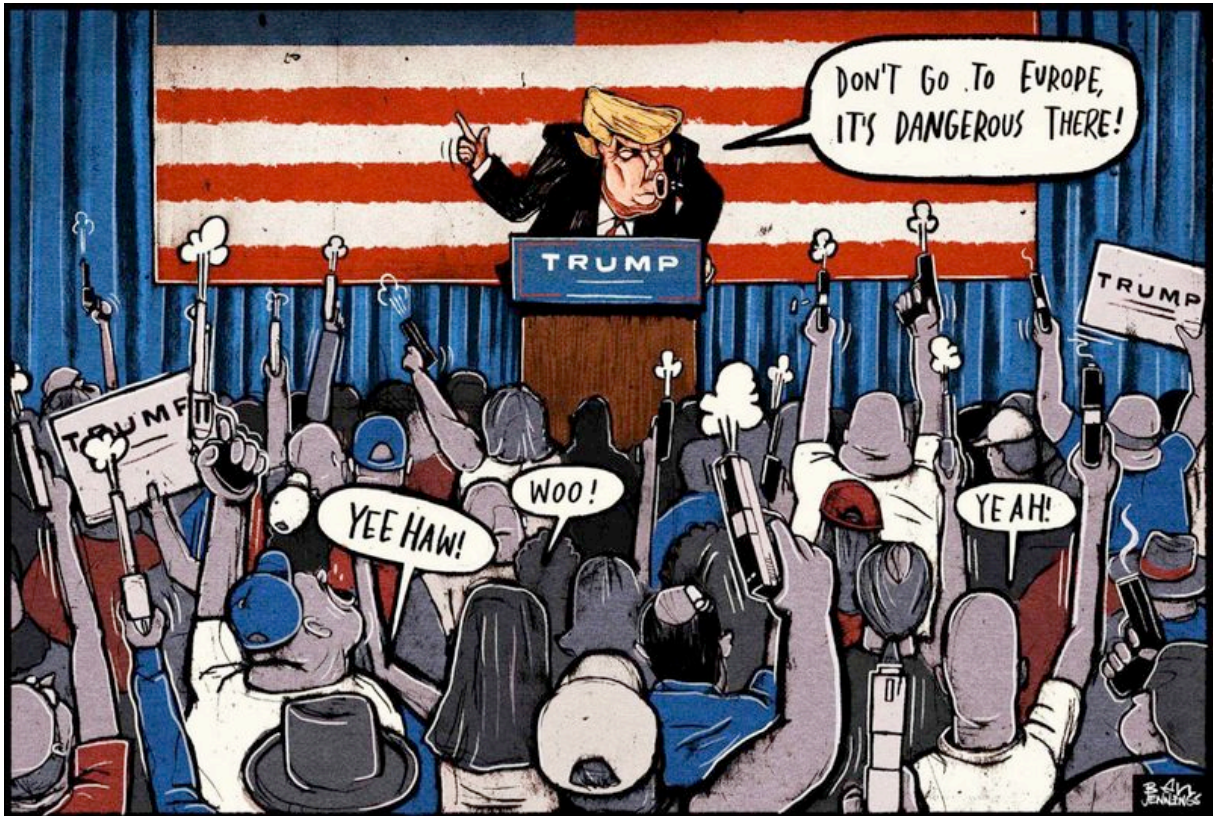


Double portrait
