Industry : Science, Research and Engineering

➤ The **[Doctoral Student Program](#)** is aimed at postgraduate students preparing a doctoral thesis in applied physics, engineering or computing to spend between 12 to 36 months at CERN. Students specializing in theoretical or experimental particle physics are not eligible under the Programme

To be eligible, candidates must be enrolled in a doctoral programme by the time they take up their appointment at CERN.

➤ The **[Technical Student Program](#)** offers undergraduate students in applied physics, engineering or computing the possibility to spend a training period of 4 to 12 months during the course of their studies. Students specializing in theoretical or experimental particle physics are not eligible under the Programme.

To be eligible, candidates must have completed by the summer of their stay at least 18 months of full time university studies.

There are 2 deadlines to apply for this Programme throughout the year followed by 2 Committees at which the students are selected. We kindly invite you visit our website: www.cern.ch/jobs where you can find all information about CERN Student Programmes.

This programme offers undergraduate students of physics, computing and engineering a unique opportunity to join in the day-to-day work of research teams participating in experiments at CERN in Geneva, Switzerland.

To be eligible, candidates must have completed by the summer of their stay at least 3 years of full time University studies.

The Programme is open to candidates for application from September to late January, for an internship in summer 2012.

Please note: Students from Non-Member States are able to apply for one of our programmes (Administrative, Doctoral and Technical Programme) only if they have been studying in a Member State university for the last 5 years (at the time of the application).

The following 20 countries are Member States of CERN: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, the Slovak Republic, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom. Romania and Israel are currently a “candidate for accession” and will be a full Member States in the future. Therefore, those citizens are able to apply for staff positions and all student programmes.
