

ING1 INTRODUCTION TO THE TOEIC LISTENING AND READING TEST

Format: Paper and pencil test, 200 multiple-choice questions, 2 hours.

Listening section (45 minutes, 100 questions)

1. Photographs: 6 questions
2. Question-Response: 25 questions
3. Conversations: 39 questions
 - 13 conversations
 - 3 questions per conversation
4. Talks: 30 questions
 - 10 talks
 - 3 questions per talk

Reading section (1h15 minutes, 100 questions)

1. Incomplete Sentences: 30 questions
2. Text Completion: 16 questions
3. Single Passage: 29 questions
 - 10 single passages
 - 2-4 questions per passage
4. Multiple Passages: 25 questions
 - 2 Set-Based double passages
 - 3 Set-Based triple passages
 - 5 questions per set

Lexical areas covered (business and general)

Company development and general business activities, business communication, recruitment and employment, finance, production, marketing, purchasing, technical areas.

Travel and transport, eating out, leisure, health, real estate.

Scores

Points for each section (listening and reading) are converted into scores ranging from 5 to 495 points (see conversion table as a rough guide).

Total score = sum of scores of the two sections, max 990 points.

800 points = required score to validate EISTI diploma

785 points = level B2 CECRL (minimum level usually required by universities abroad)

Procedure

Only HB pencils, erasers and photo ID are accepted in the examination room (no pens, food or drink).

ID: National identity card, passport or driving licence (not student card)

Mark ONE correct answer per question. Answer ALL the questions (no points deducted for wrong answers). Colour the circles entirely.

DO NOT MARK ANYTHING ON THE TEST BOOKLET, only on the answer grid.

Examinees are not permitted to leave the examination room if they finish the test ahead of time.
